

Ballard Hudson Middle School 23-24 Dress code

PANTS, SHORTS, OR SKIRTS:

Pants:

- Plain Khaki, black, or navy uniform pants are the only pants allowed to be worn.
- Jeans or jean material, cargo pants, leggings, and jeggings are not allowed daily.
- Pants must be of appropriate size and worn at the natural waistline.
- Pants must be worn with a belt.

Skirts:

- Plain khaki, black, or navy uniform skirts are the only skirts allowed to be worn.
- Skirts must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.

Shorts:

- Plain khaki, black, or navy uniform shorts are the only shorts allowed to be worn.
- Shorts must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.

SHIRTS:

- All shirts must be polo style, colored shirts.
- Only shirts with the following colors can be worn: white, gray, yellow/gold, maroon/burgundy.
- No hoodies are allowed.
- School t-shirts, school sweatshirts, or school sweaters may be worn.
- School-colored (white, gray, yellow/gold, maroon/burgundy) sweatshirts (with no hoods) and school-colored sweaters may be worn.

JACKETS:

No jackets with hoods or hoodies are allowed to be worn in the building.

SHOES:

- All shoes must be closed toed and closed heeled.
- No slides, crocs, or sandals are allowed.

ACCESSORIES:

- Earrings Standard-sized only (no larger than a quarter).
- No hats, do rags, scarves, or bandannas are allowed.

- No hoodies can be worn in the building.
- Dog tags, large medallions, large belt buckles etc. are NOT allowed.
- Only small purses will be allowed.
- Girls may wear hair headbands in the color black only. No hair scarves are allowed.
- Male students are not permitted to wear headbands or sweatbands.
- Belt buckles should be no wider than the belt (belts/buckles can have no lettering, pictures or sayings).
- No mace, pepper spray, or any other object deemed a weapon is allowed.

BOOKBAGS:

Only clear or mesh bookbags are allowed in the building.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:

Students shall not wear any clothing or accessory items that are gang or set related or exhibits gang behavior. This includes items that refer to deceased family members (i.e., RIP).

No clothing that advertises alcohol, drugs, sex, vulgar, profane, or lewd writing, pictures, emblems, or promotes aggression or violence is allowed.

All other items, which in the judgment of the principal (designee), disrupt or distract from the teaching and learning process will not be allowed.

Any item prohibited in the Bibb County BOE Guidelines for Success or Dress Code is not allowed.
